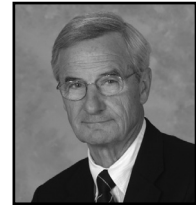

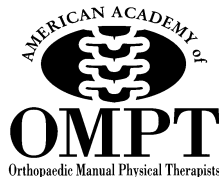
CFMT: CERTIFICATION IN FUNCTIONAL MANUAL THERAPY

To become a Certified Functional Manual Therapist is to demonstrate a mastery of skills and clinical expertise. Testing covers eight courses, plus one course of choice. Graduates have the further opportunity to apply for a year-long Fellowship (accredited by the APTA) - or short-term Residency - at Johnson & Johnson Physical Therapy in Steamboat Springs, CO. IPA has certified over 120 PTs since the inception of the program in 1997.

FOC: FUNCTIONAL ORTHOPEDIC CERTIFICATION

This certification prepares therapists for a general orthopedic setting. It tests therapists' skills of assessment and treatment for articular, soft tissue and neuromuscular dysfunctions. Testing covers four courses. Open to PTs, PTAs and OTs.
